Tapestry Online Journal: you all will be receiving a letter about the next steps in rolling out parent access to their child's journal on Tapestry. All families will receive a letter by email before the end of this half term followed by activation links early next half term. Please keep an eye out in your junk/spam folders and/or have a word if you do not receive further information about Tapestry from us. Parent Consultations: we plan to hold face-to-face parent consultations on Friday 19<sup>th</sup> November. Parent consultations are an opportunity to chat with your child's key person about how your child is settling into (or back into) Pre-School and the progress they are making. Staff also complete a Learning Development check for each child, which will be available on Tapestry before the meetings. Meetings will be held in the hall, subject to any changes in COVID guidance, and there is no usual session that day. We will send more information about the consultations a bit nearer the time, including details about how to book your slot.

Annual General Meeting (AGM): the Pre-School's Annual General Meeting will be held on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> October, 8pm, over Zoom. The AGM reflects on the previous year for the Pre-School and is a good opportunity for you to find out about what the Committee does and how you can help.
